As you may be aware that Union Cabinet has approved the scheme for setting up 7 PM Mega Integrated Textiles Region and Apparel Parks (PM MITRA) in Greenfield/Brownfield sites in partnership with the interested State Governments, with an outlay of Rs. 4445 crores. The scheme aims to develop integrated large scale and modern industrial infrastructure facility for entire value-chain of the textile industry which would reduce logistics costs and improve competitiveness of Indian Textiles. The scheme envisages to help India in attracting investments, boosting employment generation and position itself strongly in the global textile market. These parks are envisaged to be developed primarily in PPP mode.

- 2. One of the basic requirements of setting up of PM MITRA Parks is that the interested state government should have ready availability of contiguous and encumbrance-free land parcel of minimum 1000 acres, which will be transferred to the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) at notional price.
- 3. The Textiles Industry has potential to boost economy of country and state where they are located. It also has the potential for generating employment opportunities for large number of persons. In order to take forward the textile sector to new heights, I look forward to the support of your State Government. Therefore, I shall be grateful if you would send proposal from your state to the Ministry for consideration latest by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2022. The Scheme Notification and Operational Guidelines are enclosed for your reference. If you have any other query in this regard then kindly feel free to approach me or any other officer of Ministry of Textiles.
