

here's no dearth of fashion blogs for women in India but what about those men who seek fashion advice now and then? "I don't think Indian men bothered to go beyond their regular shirt and pant look but things are changing," says Riaan George, whose blog, Urban Eye, dispenses regular styling tips for men. "The Indian man is shopping as much as his wife or girlfriend, and is fashion-conscious, which is why men's fashion blogs are being appreciated in India now." Jeremy Cabral, a full-time fashion blogger at Fashion Most Wanted, says that bloggers abroad work in tandem with advertising network agencies to market their blogs and generate revenues, a concept undeveloped in India. "If the trend fully develops, it will be a good incentive for many to start blogging," he says.

Styling men is no mean feat, though. "Making a bold statement without going over-the-top is probably the most challenging aspect of styling a man's outfit," says Purushu Arie, who blogs at Purushu Arie, and is a fashion designer himself. For Riaan, translating trends from the streets of Europe to that of Delhi and Mumbai is the challenge. "For example, you wouldn't wear a checked wool suit and a waistcoat with exquisite Italian leather shoes to walk around in Mumbai but you could wear all of these as separates," he says.

we ask the designers to share their easiest style advice. "Use blue, grey and black somewhere in your wardrobe. These colours will never let you down," suggests Riaan. Jeremy agrees, saying, "Men should definitely invest in jackets and blazers in darker shades like black or navy blue; they will do justice to your waistline and cover unflattering areas of your upper body." 
